















Press down both wheel adjuster tabs and slide wheel holders to desired width. Check tolerance and repeat steps if necessary to find ideal width of wheel holders for your bicycle's tyres.




- Use appropriate saftey equipment when drilling



Install jaw at height of centre axle of front wheel




Horizontal storage


To store bike vertically:


Roll bike on back wheel and guide front wheel firmly into jaw. Check bike is stable and secure before leaving bike unattended.
