


Adjust numbers to personal code




Turn reset dial 1/4 turn back


LOCKING AND UNLOCKING



Insert male part into Locking cylinder




2 Change numbers To lock




To open / unlock change Numbers to personal code

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



- DO wear your Hiplok over at least one layer of clothing and ensure it is not able to slip down the body. Ensure it is comfortable before riding
- DO check size guide for waist dimensions. Hiplok is not intended for use by children
- DO be aware of your surroundings and always treat road vehicles, pedestrians and other cyclists with caution. Wear appropriate hi-vis
 clothing and bicycle lights when riding at night
- ALWAYS ride safely and to your own ability. Regularly check your bike for general maintenance issues such as brake and tire wear
- HIPLOK has been designed to reduce the risks associated with wearing a chain or lock on the body. However, extra care should always be taken when using any such product in this way to avoid potential accidents and injuries
- Look after your lock by occasionally using a small amount of metal lubricant in the padlock mechanism. Your sleeve can be removed by unscrewing the bolts then washed and wiped clean
- Always lock your bike to a secure fixing and if possible ensure lock is away from the ground. For more information log on to www.hiplok.com
